**Syracuse, NY**– [InterFaith Works of Central New York](http://www.interfaithworkscny.org) has appointed three new staff members: **Diego Costa** has been appointed the agency's accounting manager, **Ana Guerrero** has been appointed employment services specialist with the agency's Center for New Americans, and **Peggy Woods** has been appointed volunteer coordinator for the agency's Senior Services Program.

As accounting manager, **Costa** is responsible for InterFaith Works' contract management, financial statements preparation, cash flow analysis and general ledger reconciliation. He had previously served as a fiscal aide at the Spanish Action League of Onondaga County and as vice director of finance at the International Tourism Institute, Santiago of Cuba, Cuba. A resident of Syracuse, Costa holds a bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Oriente, Santiago de Cuba, Cuba.

A resident of Syracuse, **Guerrero** will assist the Center for New Americans' refugee clients with job preparation and in finding and retaining employment. Before joining InterFaith Works, she was most recently a career coordinator for the Spanish Action League of Onondaga County and had served as the chief operations officer and as a consultant for Mecánicas Draguer in Barcelona, Spain. Guerrero holds a bachelor's degree in sociology and a master's degree in human resources management and administration from Barcelona University in Barcelona, Spain.

**Woods** is responsible for coordinating the work of 60 senior companions who provide support to nearly 200 frail seniors in three Central New York counties. Before joining InterFaith Works, Woods had most recently served as director of the Women's Opportunity Center, which helps lead low-income women out of poverty. She holds a master of science degree in business management from SUNY Institute of Technology, Utica. Woods resides in E. Syracuse, NY.
