INTERFAITH WORKS OF CNY TO HOLD INTERFAITH DINNER DIALOGUES ON SEPT. 17 TO INCREASE UNDERSTANDING

SYRACUSE, NY – **Interfaith Dinner Dialogues**, during which small groups of people share their personal thoughts about faith and spirituality, will be held on **Thursday, Sept. 17, from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.** in host residences in and around Syracuse. Organized by InterFaith Works of Central New York's El-Hindi Center for Dialogue, the dialogues are free and open to the public. Dialogue groups for adults and youths will be held.

A trained facilitator will guide and moderate the dialogue, so participants feel comfortable sharing their thoughts. A simple vegetarian meal will be provided by dialogue hosts. Sharing a meal is an outward expression of unity among those with varied beliefs and religious traditions.

A training session for facilitators will be held on **Monday, Aug. 31, at 5:30 p.m.** at InterFaith Works, 1010 James St., Syracuse.
