MEDIA ADVISORY: INTERFAITH WORKS OF CNY CELEBRATES ONE YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF RELOCATION TO SYRACUSE

The agency purchased and renovated a 50-year-old building to house its human service programs to support the revitalization efforts of the city and because of its easy accessibility for clients who often rely on public transportation. As part of the celebration, a sign created by Brendan Rose, Salt Quarters and Stone Quarry Hill Art Park art-in-residence (2014/2015 and 2013, respectively), who is well-known for creating public art in Syracuse, will be dedicated.
