Keynote Speaker: Keith A. Alford, Ph.D.

Dr. Keith A. Alford is Director and Associate Professor of the School of Social Work at Syracuse University. His research and teaching areas are child welfare, family mental health, multiculturalism, and culturally specific human service intervention. He earned a bachelor's degree in history and sociology from Coker College and a Master of Social Work degree and Ph.D. from The Ohio State University. Dr. Alford has published in such journals as *African American Studies*, *Family Social Work*, and *Families in Society*. He has written book chapters in *Mental Health Care in the African American Community* (Haworth Press) and *Educating Our Black Children* (Routledge). He is also the co-editor of *Rural Families and Reshaping Human Services* (Routledge). Locally, he is a member of Bethany Baptist Church and serves on the Board of Directors for InterFaith Works. Dr. Alford espouses the African proverb, "I am because we are, and because we are—therefore I am."

Workshop A: Cultivating Inclusion-Stories from the Edges, Moderated By Peter Willner

The goal will be to give guidance to others who are considering the same path, and to open general discussion what Sanctuary really means in this context
